



| Organization and country: Bulgaria Training, Bulgaria |
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| Name of the activity: Safety Survivor |
| Overview (What I am going to learn?): Whether I'm well informed and aware of all the health & safety rules in the company as well as the procedures that must be followed in a typical work scenario. |
| Objective (What am I going to learn it for?): To make sure that I'm safe at work and follow correctly all the guidelines and procedures in each situation. |
| Materials: Workplace Safety Survival Worksheet (an example below) |
| Time: 45-60 min |
| Target group: All employees |

Instructions for facilitators

Think about common safety rules and work procedures and put them down on a list that will be called "Workplace Safety Survival Worksheet". The activities will be called "safety stations" and are expected to be completed by the participants.

Make sure to print out enough copies of the Workplace Safety Survival Worksheet.

Book a big room in the office to gather the employees and tell them about the instructions, the rules and the prize for the winners to encourage and motivate the participants.

Divide the group into at least two teams and hand out to them the Workplace Safety Survival Worksheet.





Tasks and procedure:

- 1. Divide participants into at least two teams.
- 2. Select the safety stations that you would like to use for the game.
- 3. Prepare a Workplace Safety Survival Worksheet listing all of the selected safety stations.
- 4. Give each participant (or group) the Workplace Safety Survival Worksheet
- 5. Ask participants to successfully complete each safety station as a team.
- 6. After successfully completing each station, the team will receive a token.
- 7. The team that completed the greatest number of safety stations in the least time wins.
- 8. Award ceremony.
